**I. Welcome/Call to Order - Board Chair Heather Rodriguez**

A meeting of the Irvington Community Schools Board of Governance was held in person at Irvington Community Middle School on Tuesday, May 26, 2026. The Board of Governors present were Heather Rodriguez, Keith Young, Erica Young, Justin Hagen, Chloe Edwards, and Madison Monfreda. Ms. Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m.

**II. Review and Approval of April Board Minutes**

**III. COO/Interim CEO Report - Erica Young**

Erica Young presented the CEO report on behalf of Rod Iberg and referenced a letter that Rod distributed to the township schools informing them of Irvington's intent to participate in the referendum.

**IV. Interim CAO Report- Rosemary McCloskey**

Mrs. McCloskey presented academic updates on ILEARN, IREAD, NWEA, Acadience, scorecard data, and attendance. Mrs. McCloskey informed us that there are a total of 144 students enrolled in summer school across all three schools. Summer school will begin on June 1, 2026.

Mrs. McCloskey presented the ICES update including information regarding the selection of a math screener. The plan is to implement the screener for all K-5 students in an effort to align the data across grade levels. The cost to purchase the screener will be covered by the DOE assessment grant.
